COURSE FEES

This Product Workshop has a fee of \$25 per session. Attendees receive a \$100 DoorKing Coupon for each session they attend which can be used for the purchase of DoorKing product.

This "DKU On the Road" workshop is an intensive hands on training program. These are full day sessions that focus on installation, wiring and programming, with attendees working with live equipment.

There are two sessions available:

Access Control Workshop:

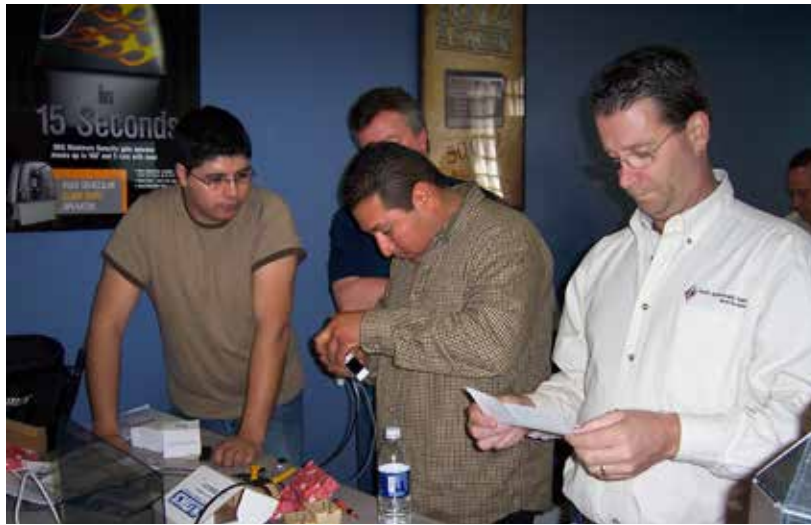
Attendees work with an 1830 series controller, card readers and tracker boards to build a working access control system. Training includes general installation guidelines, wiring card access devices into the 1830 series controller and trouble shooting techniques. We also provide Wireless Modules to work with the Wireless Tracker option. Attendees who bring their Laptop PC's will also work with programming their systems to set up various access parameters.

Gate Operator Workshop:

Work stations are set up with various DoorKing Gate Operator models. Attendees will wire various types of controls and accessories into the gate operator to set up a fully functional gate system. Training includes general installation guidelines, safety requirements, how controls & accessories interact with the gate operator, and system setting required to bring the operator online. We also discuss Loop Detection systems and provide field trouble shooting techniques for gate systems.

** When the two Full Day Sessions are combined, attendees will tie their Access Control system from Day 1 into the Gate system for a fully interactive system.*

These are typically a 1/2 or full day, held at the distributor location. They are not typically very "hands on". They are more informative. Ordinarily the Regional Manager will use PowerPoints and handouts to focus on selected products or product groups. We set up Classroom style (rows of tables) and provide lunch.

Distributor Days are great ways for Dealers to keep up on new products, and get valuable training for sales and technical staff. These seminars may include product demonstrations.

A variation of this that some distributors like is to just set up with some equipment in the will call area for a day. We provide lunch and dealers stop by and look at our featured products and talk. No formal sessions. Or the distributor promotes short 1 hr sessions 3 times a day that dealers can come in for. Morning session, before lunch and after lunch.
